- Charlotte Hall Veterans Home is a program under the Maryland State Department of Veterans & Military Families- Edward C. Rothstein is Secretary under Governor Wes Moore
 - Opened in 1985- Celebrating 40 years of “Serving Those Who Served”
 - US Dept. of Veterans Affairs funding through a grant program called “State Veteran Home and Construction Grant Program” 65% US Dept. of Veterans Affairs funding- 35% State of Maryland Funding
 - 318 Skilled Nursing Beds + 126 Assisted Living Beds =444 total beds

- Room Rates: Assisted Living \$177.00-\$180.00 per day, Skilled Nursing Facility \$286.00-\$290.00 per day depends on private room, semi-private room, or memory care room
- Number of Rooms: AL # 30 single & 100 double, SNF # 86 single, & 100 double rooms
- 2025 Average Occupancy: 57%
- April 01 – April 30, 2026: 11 Admissions, 1 Discharged, 5 Expired
- 41% of the population is between the ages of 70-79
- Population includes 12 female veterans & 31 female spouses
- 96% of the veteran population served during wartime
- 49% of the veteran population served in the U.S. Army
- Distinguished Medal Recipients:
 - 3 Bronze Star
 - 5 Purple Heart

How is Charlotte Hall Veterans Home different from other nursing or assisted living facilities?

- Charlotte Hall Veterans Home serves veterans and their eligible spouses
- On-Site Medical Services: Attending Physicians, Nursing Practitioners, Dental, Optometry, Podiatry, Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy, and Speech Therapy
- On-Site Pharmacy, Pharmacist, and Pharm Techs
- On-Site Barber and Beauty Shop, Massage Therapy/Pain Management Practitioner
- On-Site Veterans Service Officer- Certified by US Dept. of Veterans Affairs
- Robust Volunteer Program
- More affordable- current USDVA Per Diem Rates (Effective October 1, 2025):
 - \$148.71 per day for Nursing Home Care = \$4,535.66 per month savings
 - \$64.19 per day for Assistant Living Care = \$1,957.80 per month savings
 - A VP1- 70% or greater Service-Connected Veteran may be entitled to the full cost of nursing home care.
